Questions raised by those in attendance included the cost comparison between switching entirely to Kingbrook vs maintaining a 50/50 blend, whether the Board had gathered sufficient resident input, general concerns regarding the water supply, and whether the decision should be put to a public vote.

The Board addressed the need to decide and move forward with one of the options in the March 2025 Water Study as presented by DGR Engineering.

Motion by Beyer, seconded by Fischer for Kingbrook to provide individual service to residents of Ramona. Two votes yes, one vote no. Motion passes.

Second reading of Ordinance 257-25. An ordinance adding flood damage prevention regulations to the ordinances of the Town of Ramona. Three votes yes, zero votes no.
